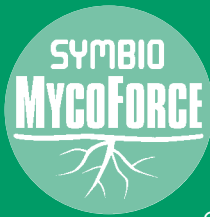

- ◆ Contains wetting agents to aid water penetration and prevent dew formation
- ◆ Use as a treatment or a preventative

STRONG, STRESS-RESISTANT SPORTS TURF

Symbio PhytoGro employs a unique combination of: Fatty Acids, Fruit Acids and Vitamins with a wetting agent/penetrant and foliar potassium.

- ◆ **Biostimulants** to promote the growth of plant hormones essential to combat stress caused by disease and dry patch.
- ◆ **Wetting agents** to aid water penetration and dispersal.
- ◆ **Potassium (0.0.18)** to increase cell production and harden the sward.

AREAS OF USE

All turf areas including golf and bowling greens, tees, approaches, surrounds and fairways, summer and winter season pitches. Particularly for stressed turf suffering frequent disease attacks. Phytogro is suitable for all turf species.

APPLICATION and TIMING

To help condition your turf against dry patch and disease apply once every 4 weeks approaching and during the time turf diseases and dry patch are expected.

Immediate action treatment to aid recovery: Apply at first signs of dry patch or disease to strengthen unaffected grass (PhytoGro does not work on dead grass or when the soil temperature is below 6°C and the grass is not growing)

How to use: Dilute 1 litre in 20 litres of water per 500 sq m (20 litres in 400 litres water per hectare).

FOR BEST RESULTS

For nutrient rich diseases such as fusarium, degrade surplus thatch with Symbio Thatch Eater or Green Circle, use fertilisers efficiently and ensure that excess nutrient has been utilised for plant growth before the disease season arrives.

For anthracnose, use with Symbio MycoGro Fertilisers to ensure maximum nutrient take-up by the plant for a strong healthy sward.

For Dry Patch, use in conjunction with Symbio Thatch Eater or Green Circle to remove the thatch and/or out compete the mycelia that often cause the problem.

Symbio PhytoGro may be used alone or as part of a biological treatment programme to solve underlying problems. Dry patch and plant diseases are symptoms of problems in the rootzone and sward. Contact Symbio to help solve the underlying problem.
